1. INTRODUCTION

Customer Account Functionality

Any login, authentication, customer portal, purchase history, download management or account management features that may be provided through the Website now or in the future.

The Website may use trusted third-party providers whose services require the use of Cookies.

- Other trusted providers necessary for the operation of the Website

Cookie Expiry

Cookie retention periods vary according to their purpose.

Some Cookies expire automatically when a browsing session ends whilst others may remain stored for longer periods to support Website functionality and user preferences.
